Issue and purpose of the “Débats d'EUROGIP 2014”

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The 2014 Eurogip Discussions (“Débats d'EUROGIP”) will be held on 20 March (in Paris). They will cover the existing systems at the level of the Community or the EU Member States to encourage enterprises to either reduce the incidence rate or improve health and safety in the workplace.

Rebates, aids, subsidies, labels, inspections, communication campaigns, etc.: the speakers will present various examples of systems which are often combined.

The Eurogip Discussions aim to facilitate discussions on experience regarding a topical subject on the European level. They are intended for representatives of the public authorities, enterprises (safety managers, committees for health, safety and working conditions, HR, etc.), the social partners and insurers, and for industrial doctors, occupational risk prevention personnel, consultants, academics, etc.

The “Débats d'EUROGIP” will be organised in the form of round table discussions and moderated by the journalist Régis de Closets.
