CEN-CLC New Procedures 2016-06 (changes to ENQ and FV)

Background

For the Enquiry and Formal Vote prodecure changes will be introduced as from 1st July 2016 through decisions CEN/BT 44/2015 and D152/028, taken by CEN and CENELEC respectively. CEN has created the enclosed infographic to highlight the main aspects of these decisions that apply to both CEN and CENELEC. Also attached is an in-depth background of the decisions.



The CEN and CENELEC Technical Boards have approved new changes to the Enquiry and Formal Vote procedure which come into force on 1 July 2016.



The Formal Vote period remains 2 months long, but it will no longer be allowed to extend the voting period.

New Approach Consultants assessment will take place during the Formal Vote, not beforehand.


CCMC will launch the Formal Vote directly after the editing process. Translation into the remaining official language versions will be in parallel to the Formal Vote, although a pre vote translation period may still be requested by AFNOR, BSI, DIN,DKE.

It will be obligatory for at least 1 working draft to be circulated in the TC within 4 months of adoption/activation of the WI.




Submission of draft to CCMC for Formal Vote: For CEN specifically, a TC decision is no longer required. It can be decided by the TC Chairperson & Secretary.



All new work items registered as of 1st July will have a 'First delivery of Enquiry draft' target date within 8 months, instead of 12 months, after adoption/ activation of WI.
