Health and safety at work, a performance lever for the company

## **ISSUE OF THE CONFERENCE**

Often seen as a constraint and a financial burden, occupational safety and health (OSH) nevertheless represents a lever of performance for the company and can be highly profitable. This often underestimated aspect will be at the heart of the EUROGIP Discussions on 2 March 2017.

In the introduction to the conference, experts will help us better understand the concepts that will be discussed throughout the day.

A first round table will be devoted to international and European analyzes relatives to the cost / benefit ratio of health and safety at work or rehabilitation, to the costs of psychosocial risks or to the economic advantage of health and safety at work for SMEs.

A second round table will bring together companies of various sizes and sectors that will demonstrate the return on investment of measures put in place to prevent occupational risks (related to wood dust, handling of loads) or to promote employee well-being. We will also discuss the partnership between employer and OSH expert to combine health at work and performance.

In conclusion, the floor will be given on the one hand to the representatives of the European social partners and on the other to the Occupational Risks Department in France and to the Communication Direction of the Accident insurance in Germany.

## **OBJECTIVE OF THE CONFERENCE**

Since 2003, EUROGIP has organised an annual conference on a theme related to the prevention or accident insurance - occupational diseases in Europe. The objective of the EUROGIP Discussions is to promote the exchange of information and good practices among participants at European level.
