HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK STANDARDS PUBLISHED

NF EN 1459-4 Rough-terrain trucks - Safety requirements and verification - Part 4: Additional requirements for variable-reach trucks handling freely suspended loads

NF EN 12463 Revision Food processing machinery - Filling machines and interchangeable equipment - Safety and hygiene requirements
